DAY 1:

Arrival Salvador

Guests will be greeted on arrival at Salvador airport and then transferred to the hotel Overnight at the hotel

DAY 2:

After breakfast, the driver will pick up passengers at the hotel. About the tour – Historic City Tour in Salvador: Regular historical tour departing from Salvador hotels in the morning (NOT ACHIEVED IN CARNIVAL PERIOD) Historical City Tour: Departure from the hotels of SALVADOR to Fort Santo Antônio da Barra, built in 1536 to protect the Bay of All os Santos, in 1698 he won a Lighthouse to guide the boats that arrived, it works to this day, the Barra Lighthouse. We will visit Fort São Diogo, there we will have a wonderful view of All Saints Bay. We will pass by the Vitória Corridor, Largo do Campo Grande (one of the carnival circuits), and Avenida 7 de September. We will start our walking tour to Pelourinho (Historic Center of Salvador), with stop at the Municipal Square that has panoramic views of the Baixa City (Elevador Lacerda, trade, Port of Salvador and Modelo Market), Praça da Sé, place that keeps ruins of the first Basilica of Brazil on the side of the first Archiepiscopal Palace of Salvador. We continue the City Tour towards Largo do Pelourinho, where is the Church of the Rosário dos Pretos and the Casa de Jorge Amado Foundation. We move on to the Church and Convent of São Francisco, considered one of the most unique and rich expressions of Clay. We advise: Light and comfortable linen, low shoe, sunscreen, sunglasses and cap. NOTE: It does not include meals, entrances to museums,

About the tour – Hd Casa do Rio Vermelho (house of Jorge Amado and Zélia Gattai):
Departing from the hotels in Salvador, we will begin our tour with a visit to know the history of Jorge Amado and Zélia Gattai in a memorial that preserves the original aspects of the house where they lived since 1960. Furniture, work of art, collections of objects, documents, letters written by them and a beautiful garden full of mysteries. Then we will head home of Yemanjá, a sacred place for his devotees, who tells the beautiful story of the fishermen, from there that the procession of February 2. A stop to taste one of the most famous acarajés (optional) in Largo de Santana, where the statue of Jorge Amado and Zélia Gattai is located. We finish the tour watching the sunset of Farol da Barra.
